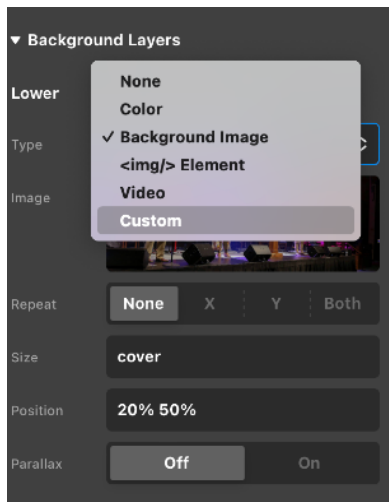


# INSERT VIDEO INTO HEADER

## VIDEO TO PLAY ONLY ON DESKTOP, IMAGE ON MOBILE

There are two different ways to insert a video into a section on the website. The first, and simplest way is to click on the section that you want to have a video background, and instead of having the option “Background Image” selected, choose “video.”

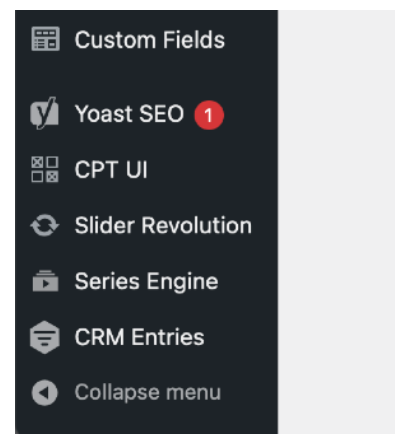


From there, you can put in a YouTube, Vimeo, or a self-hosted video (by uploading it to your the Media library in Wordpress). This works great if you want the video to play on ONLY desktop and not on mobile. The poster image that you select is how you select this.

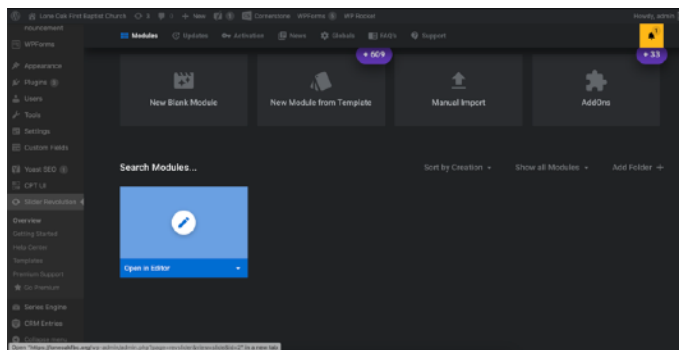
## VIDEO TO PLAY ON BOTH DESKTOP AND MOBILE (recommended)

This option is the recommended way to go; however, I have to warn you, it will slow down your website load speed. It's best to keep the video in the header to be under 20 seconds if you self host, time doesn't matter if it's on YouTube or Vimeo.

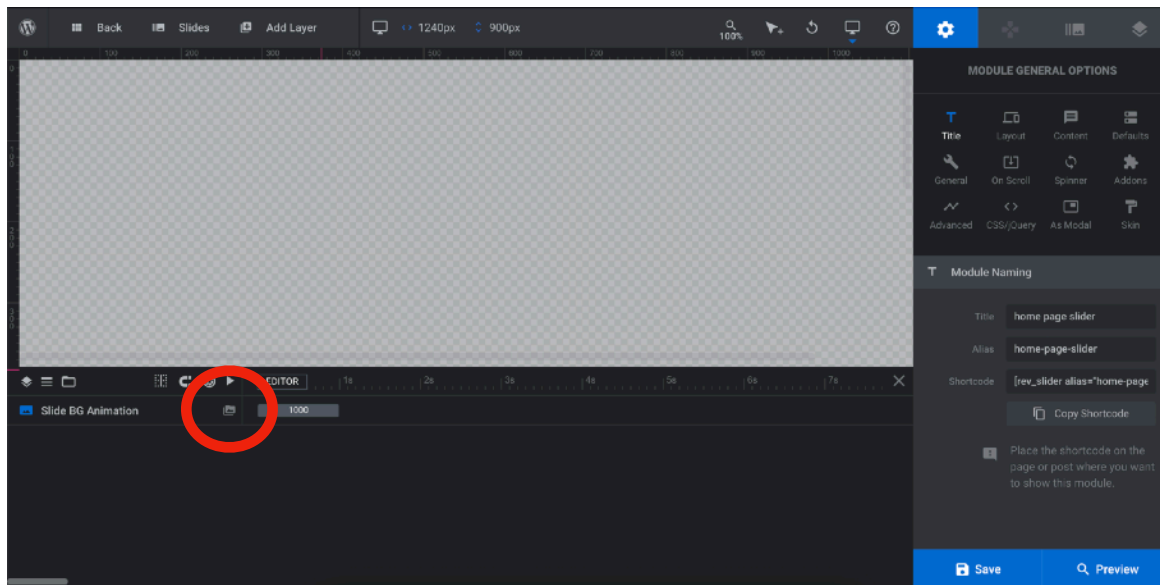
1. In the dashboard in the dock, scroll down and find “Slider Revolution.”



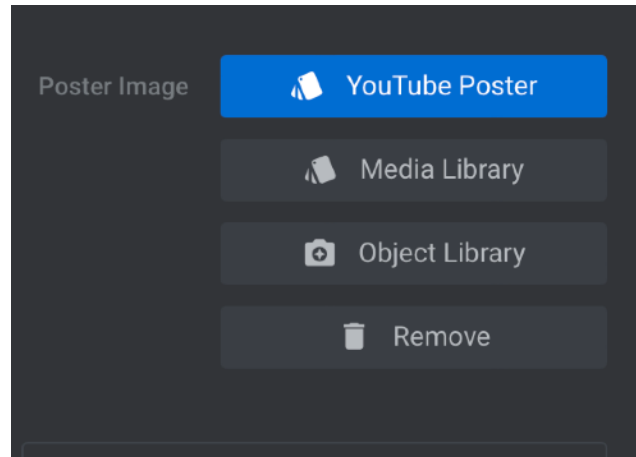
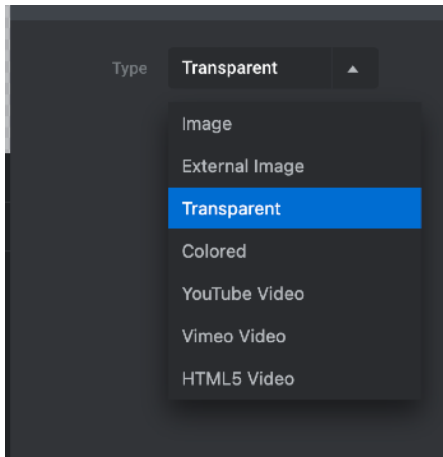
2. When you enter slider revolution, you'll see that I already created a placeholder called "home page slider." Hover over the place holder and like the pen icon to edit.



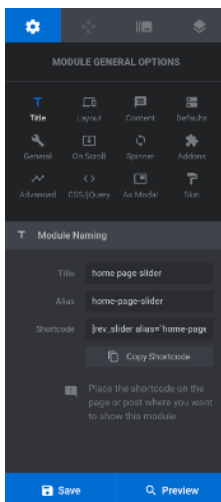
3. In the editor, click the folder icon to edit the background.



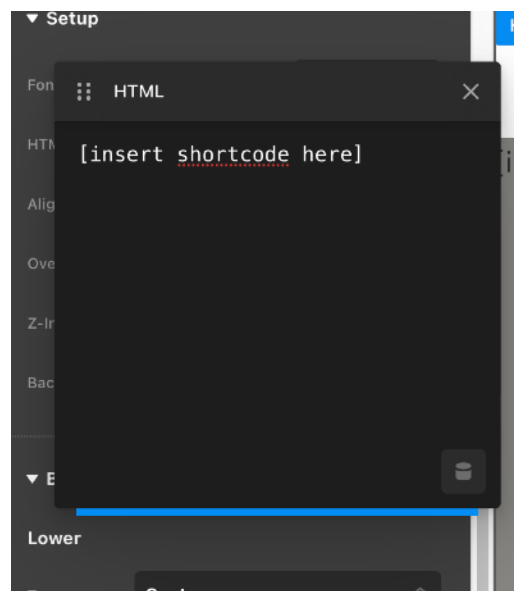
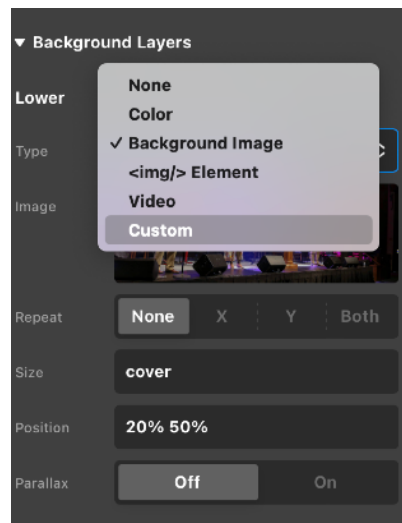
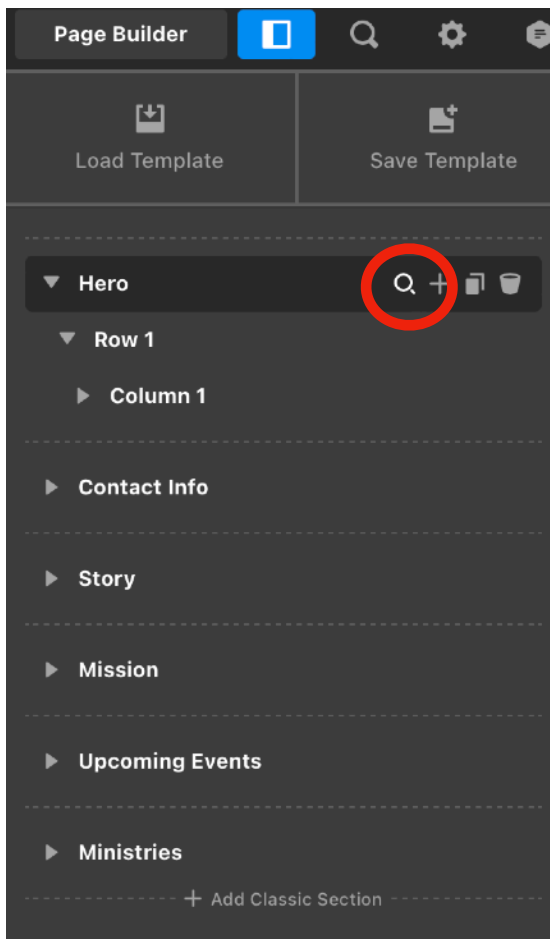
4. On the far right menu, you see options for what you want the background to be. Click the appropriate option for your video (YouTube, Vimeo, HTML 5 \*uses Wordpress media library) and then fill in the appropriate forms. You can also select a Poster Image that will show as the video loads or if the video fails to load. This is a fallback image.



5. Click the gear icon on the top right of the screen to be taken back to the “Module General Options.” There, you’ll see the short code. Copy that code, and then open up the Home page in Cornerstone.



6. In Cornerstone, select the section that you want to edit. In the “Lower Layer” options, change the option from Background Image to “Custom.” In the Content area, click “click here to edit” and paste in the shortcode. Then, click the yellow “save” button in the bottom left of the homepage.



7. Note, there may be issues with how it fits on the screen. You can change the slider revolution settings in the general settings. Play with the sizing options between auto, full-width, and full-screen.
