Context Statement: Noah lived among widespread wickedness, but he found favor with God due to his righteousness and obedience (Gen. 6:8-9). In response to humanity's corruption, God sent a flood to cleanse the earth, sparing only Noah, his family, and the animals on the ark (Gen. 7:23). After the flood, God established a covenant with Noah, promising never to destroy the earth by flood again and sealing the promise with the sign of the rainbow (Gen. 9:12-17).

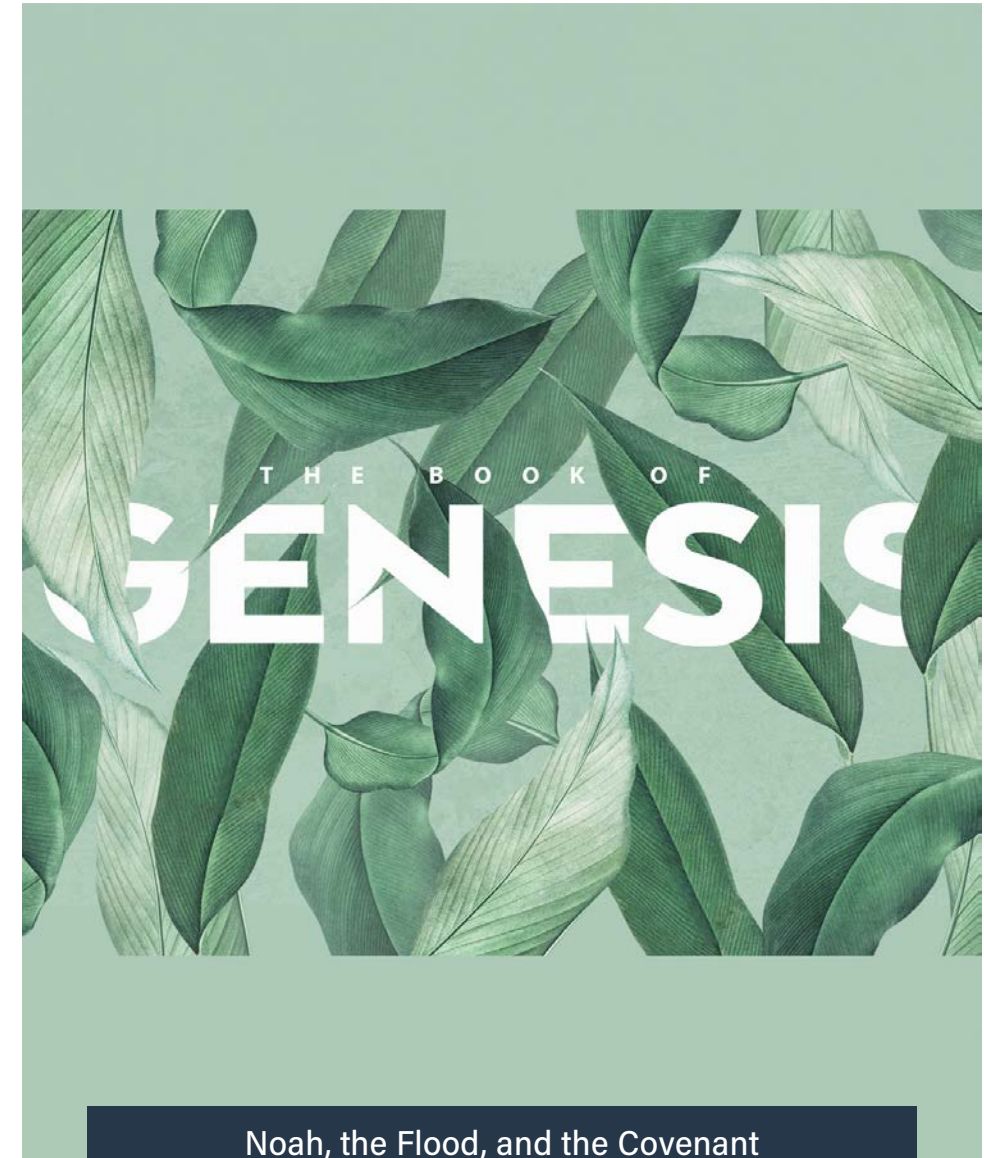
