Context Statement: Abraham, originally Abram, is a central figure in the Bible chosen by God to establish a covenant that would shape the course of redemptive history. The Abrahamic Covenant, first introduced in Genesis 12 and formalized in Genesis 15 and 17, promised Abraham descendants as numerous as the stars, the land of Canaan, and that through him all nations would be blessed. This covenant, marked by the sign of circumcision, was ultimately fulfilled in Christ Jesus.

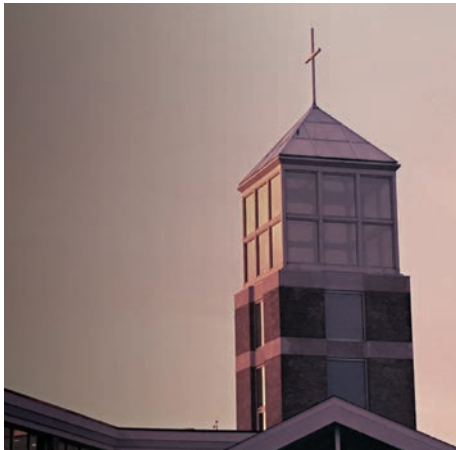
