Context Statement: Israel crossed the Jordan River, renewed their commitment to the Lord through circumcision and the Passover, marking their transition into the Promised Land. In Joshua 5:13-15, Joshua encounters the commander of the Lord's army, shifting his focus from his strategy to God's sovereign leadership. This moment underscores Israel's dependence on God, setting the stage of the Jericho victory and showing that true success comes through submission to God.

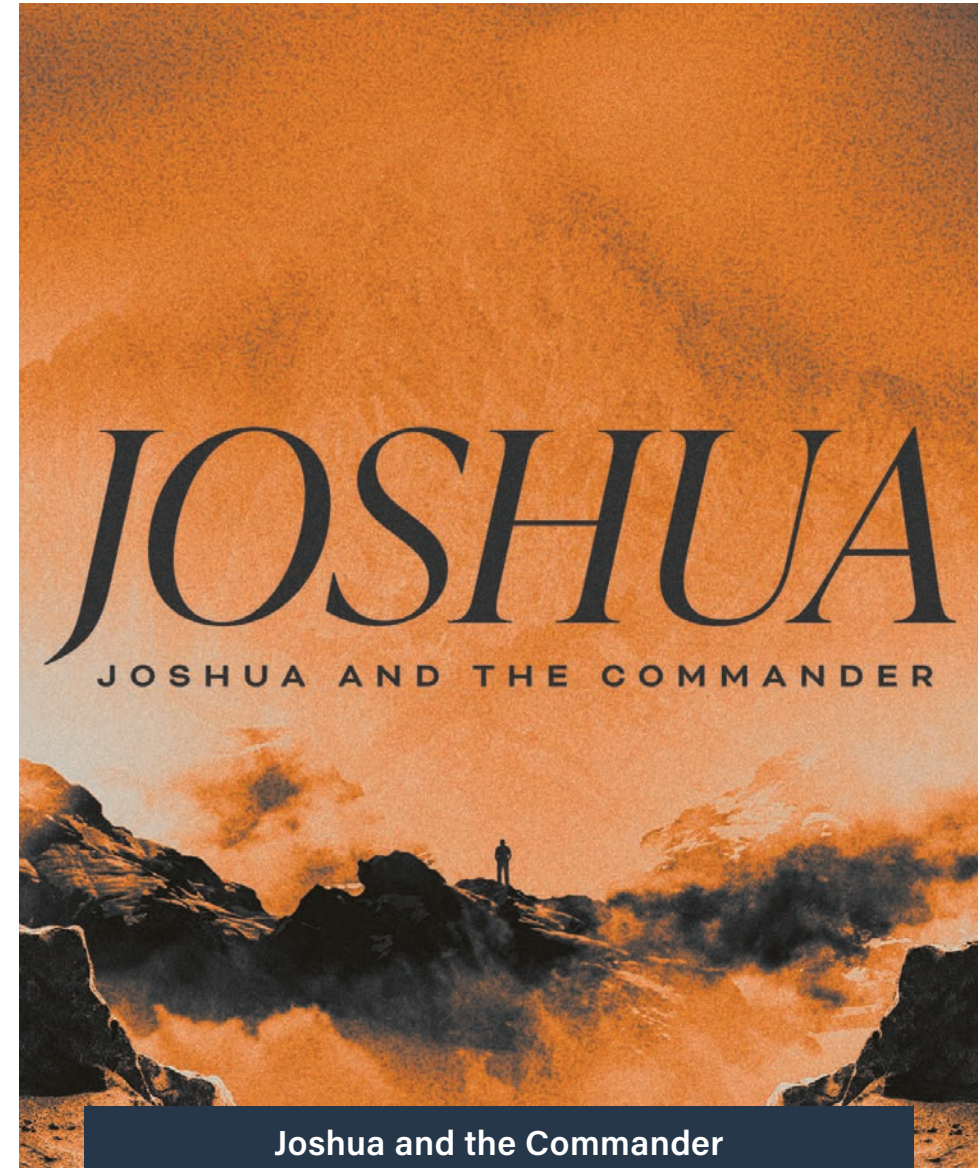
