Context Statement: 1 Samuel 25 recounts the story of Abigail, a wise and courageous woman bound to a foolish and reckless husband, and David, God's anointed king still living in exile. The narrative unfolds during a tense season when Saul remains on the throne and relentlessly seeks David's life. Through this account, we glimpse the beauty of the Gospel: the true King invites us out of bondage to sin and into His kingdom of light, not merely as servants, but as His bride.

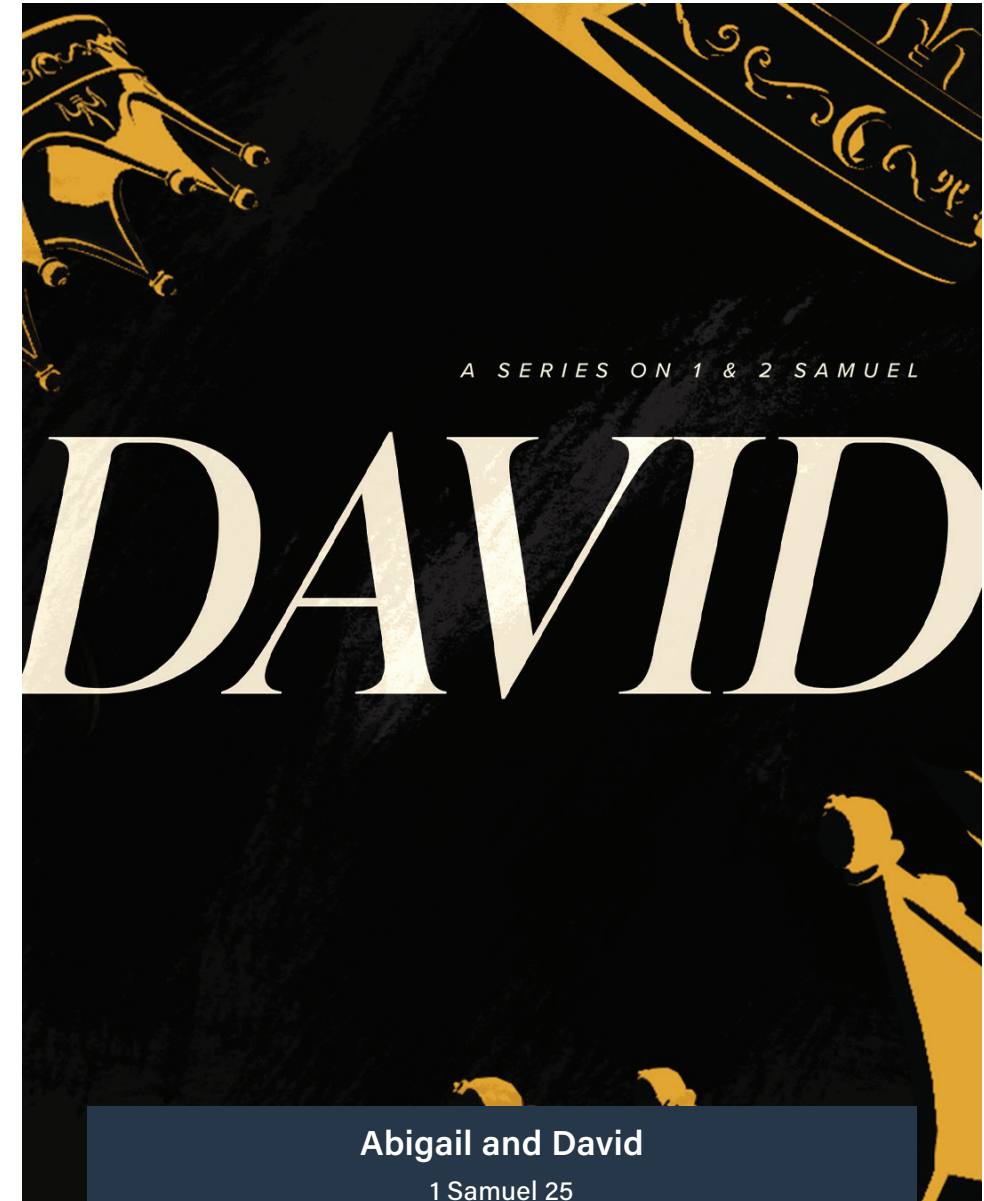

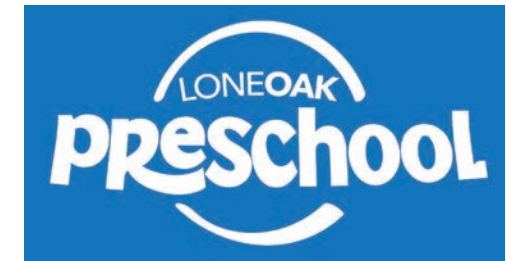
