Context Statement: As David flees Jerusalem during Absalom's rebellion, 2 Samuel 16:5-14 captures a moment of deep humiliation as he is cursed by Shimei on the road. This episode reveals the recurring Biblical theme that God uses even suffering and opposition to form His people for His purposes. Ultimately, David's posture of forgiveness points us to Jesus, who bore insult and injustice to accomplish our redemption and extend forgiveness to His enemies.

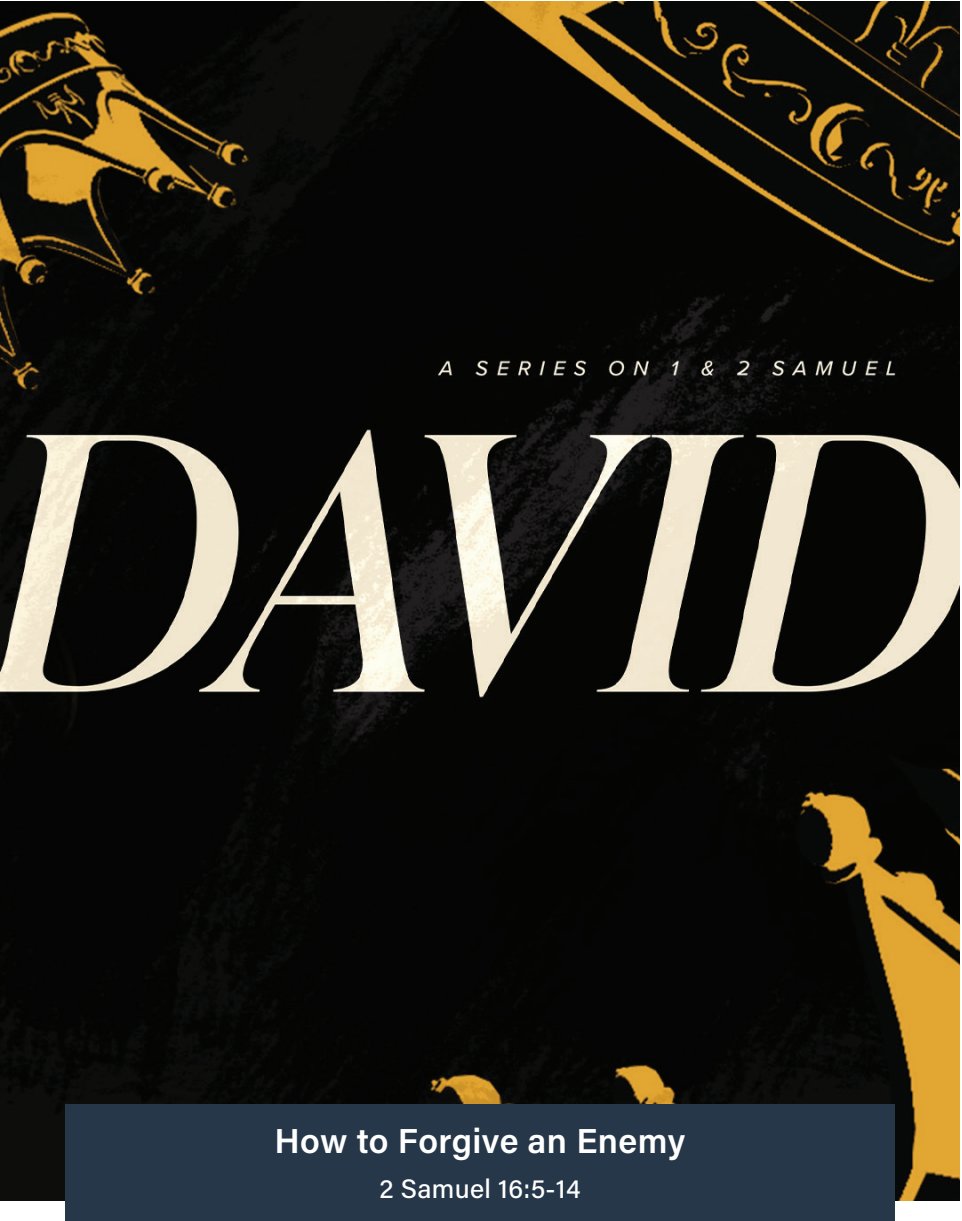
