Context Statement: In 2 Kings 18, King Hezekiah faces a terrifying threat as the mighty Assyrian empire surrounds Jerusalem and demands total surrender. Sennacherib's spokesman stands at the city wall, mocking God's power and trying to negotiate Judah's defeat through fear and deception. The passage exposes negotiation tactics the enemy still uses today to pressure the Christian into surrender.
