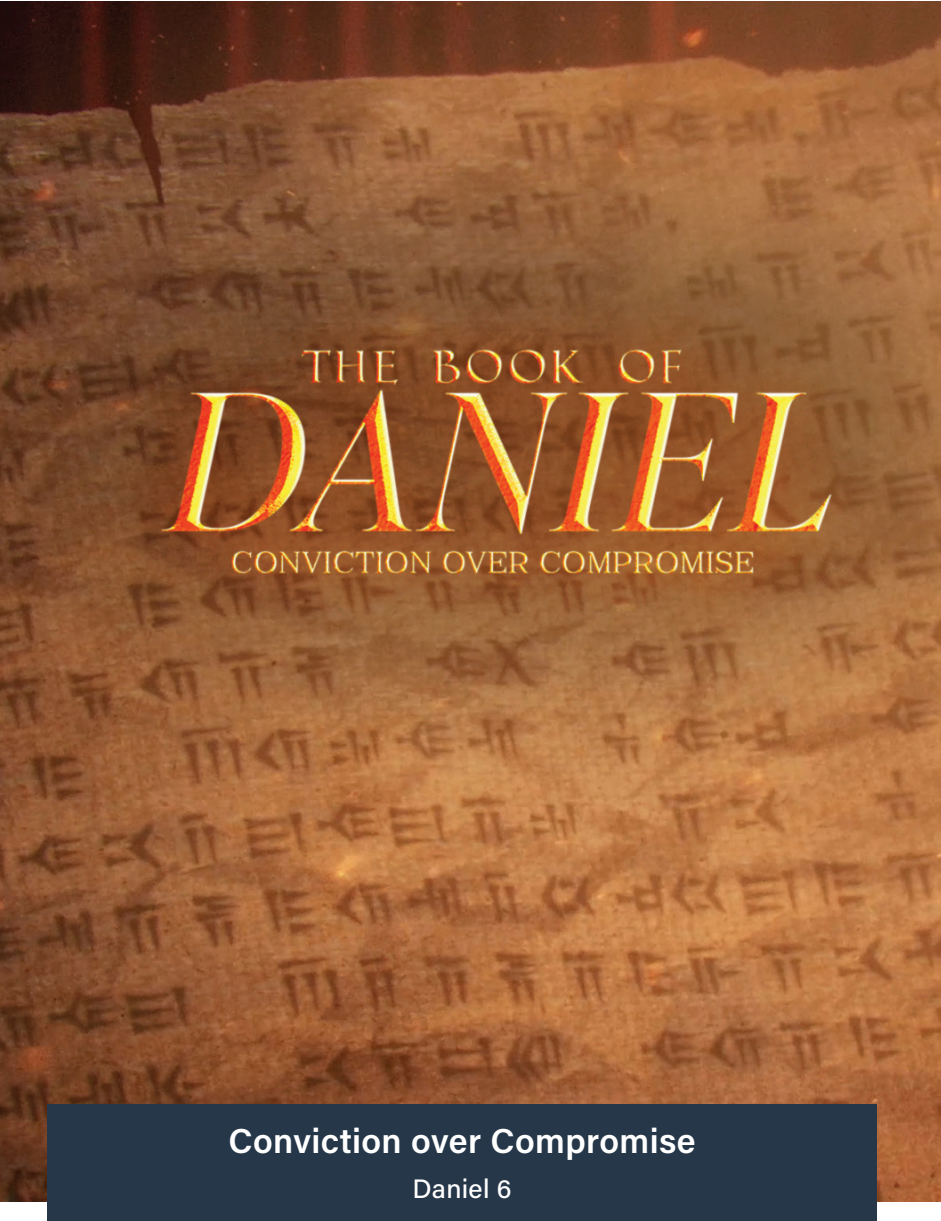
**Context Statement:** Daniel 6 takes place during the reign of Darius, ruler of the Medo-Persian Empire, which covered the majority of the known world at that time. In exile and under pressure to compromise, Daniel remained faithful to God even when it became illegal to pray. His rescue from the lions' den puts the power and glory of the living God on display and points us forward to Jesus Christ, the true King who was not only willing but able to rescue and save.

When your heart is captured by Christ, you will:
