Nehemiah 6:1-14 Dr. Scott K. Thomas II Sunday, September 7, 2025


Context Statement: In Nehemiah 6:1-14, Sanballat, Tobiah, and Geshem conspire to distract and discredit Nehemiah in an effort to halt the rebuilding of Jerusalem's wall. This episode highlights the broader theme: God's people must remain steadfast in the face of opposition as they carry out His mission. Within the larger story of Scripture, Nehemiah's perseverance points us to Christ, who resisted every scheme of the enemy to accomplish the work of redemption for His people.

or false concern, designed to, divide, and destroy.


