Context Statement: In Matthew 3:13-15 Jesus comes to the Jordan to be baptized by John, identifying Himself with the very people He came to save. Though John initially resists, Jesus insists that His baptism fulfills “all righteousness,” showing His submission to the Father’s plan and His solidarity with sinners. This moment marks the beginning of Jesus’ public ministry and sets the stage for His role as the obedient Servant who will ultimately bear the sins of the world.


