Context Statement: Acts 10 marks a pivotal point in the early church as the Gospel crosses the final major boundary between Jew and Gentile through the conversion of Cornelius. God sovereignly orchestrates two visions—one for Cornelius and one for Peter—to reveal that salvation in Christ is not limited by ethnicity, tradition, or ritual purity. This narrative demonstrates the fulfillment of God's promise that the message of Jesus would extend to "all nations," ushering in the Gentile Pentecost and the full inclusion of the Gentiles into the people of God.






