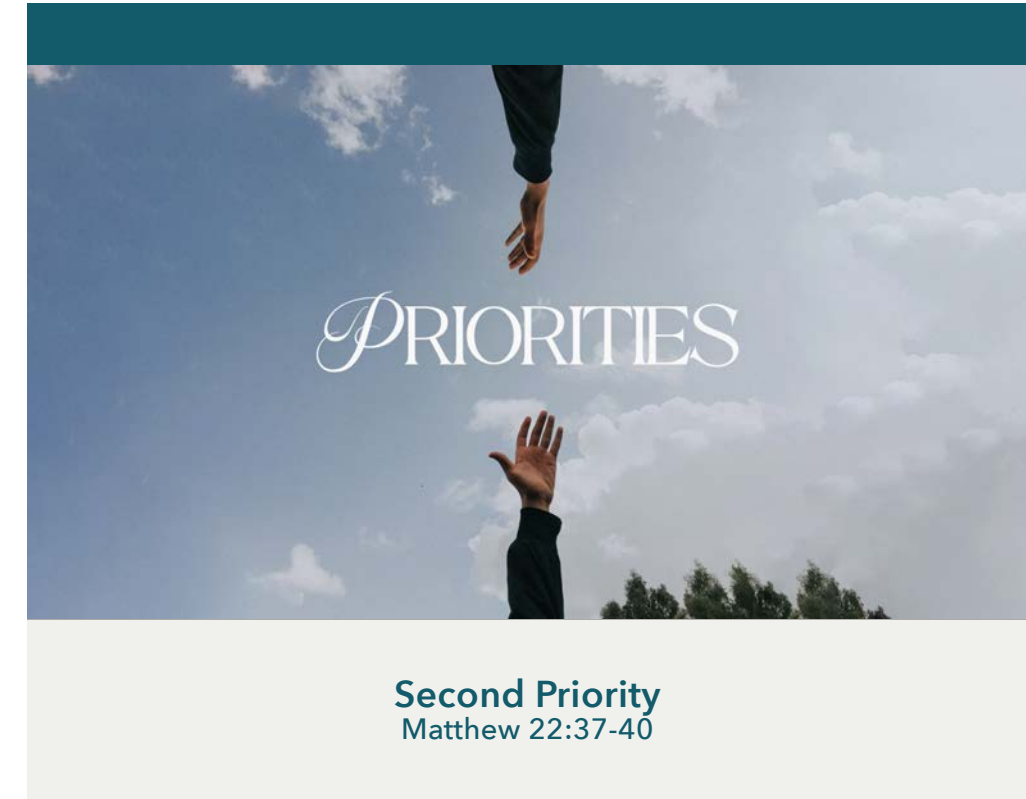

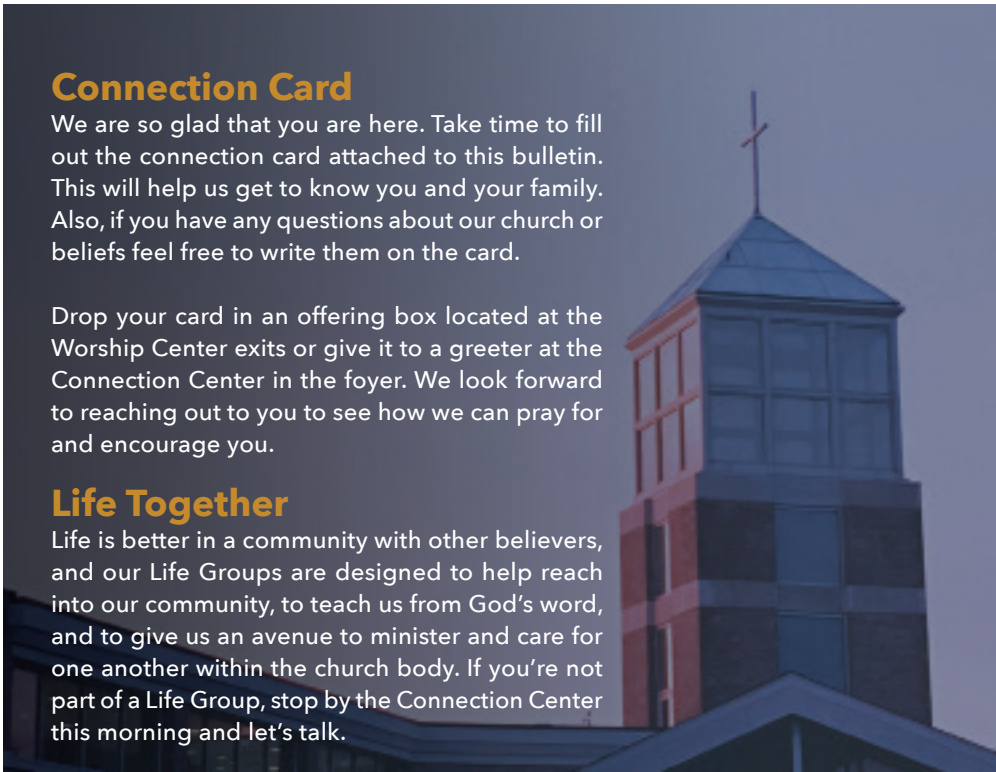

ELIZA BROADUS OFFERING

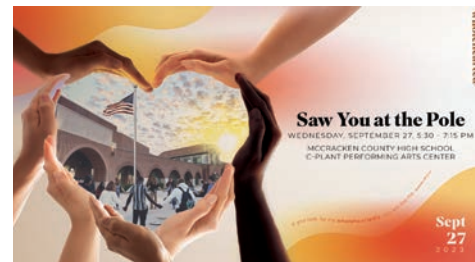
