Context Statement: The book of Job offers a biblical view of suffering, showing that righteousness does not guarantee a life of ease but calls believers to trust in God's wisdom when His purposes are hidden. Set in the land of Uz during the patriarchal period, Job's story addresses humanity's universal question about God's justice. By portraying Job as a righteous sufferer who foreshadows Christ, the book points to the ultimate Righteous Sufferer—Jesus.
