COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS AND ENDOWMENTS

HARRY ROSS SCHOLARSHIP: Award scholarship once a year to Lone Oak First Baptist Church student, preferably going into the ministry. Staff chooses this student.

RALPH AND RUTH BAKER SCHOLARSHIP: Award scholarship to student preferably from Lone Oak First Baptist Church who will be going into the field of religious music. Minister of Music and Pastor choose this student.

ED AND RUTH SHEPARD SCHOLARSHIP: Available money to be used for a young person at the direction of LOFBC

ORVILLE AMYETTE SCHOLARSHIP: Available money for church members attending church oriented college or university

RUTH SHEPARD SCHOLARSHIP: Available money to be used to award \$100 matching scholarship to student attending Southern Baptist College.

GARVICE DOUGLAS SCHOLARSHIP: The interest will go back into this scholarship until the annual interest will be at least \$250, at which time an annual scholarship will be awarded to a recipient who is a graduating senior and active member of Lone Oak First Baptist Church, pursuing a music degree, and enrolled in a credited Baptist college or university with the check made payable to that institution.

CARL and MARY L. OSBORNE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: A \$1000 continuing educational grant for a graduating high school senior with an academic rating of at least 2.8 GPA out of possible 4.0; and who has previously completed the highest grade possible at Lone Oak Middle School or the former Lone Oak High School; and is an active member of Lone Oak First Baptist Church; and recognized in the community as being of good character; and is enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college or university for the start of the next school year with a defined educational goal; and has a financial need for assistance in achieving their educational goals. This scholarship may also be awarded to a previous recipient still in school.

HARRY GOODE SCHOLARSHIP: Available money used for seminary student. Money to be divided equally between all who apply.
