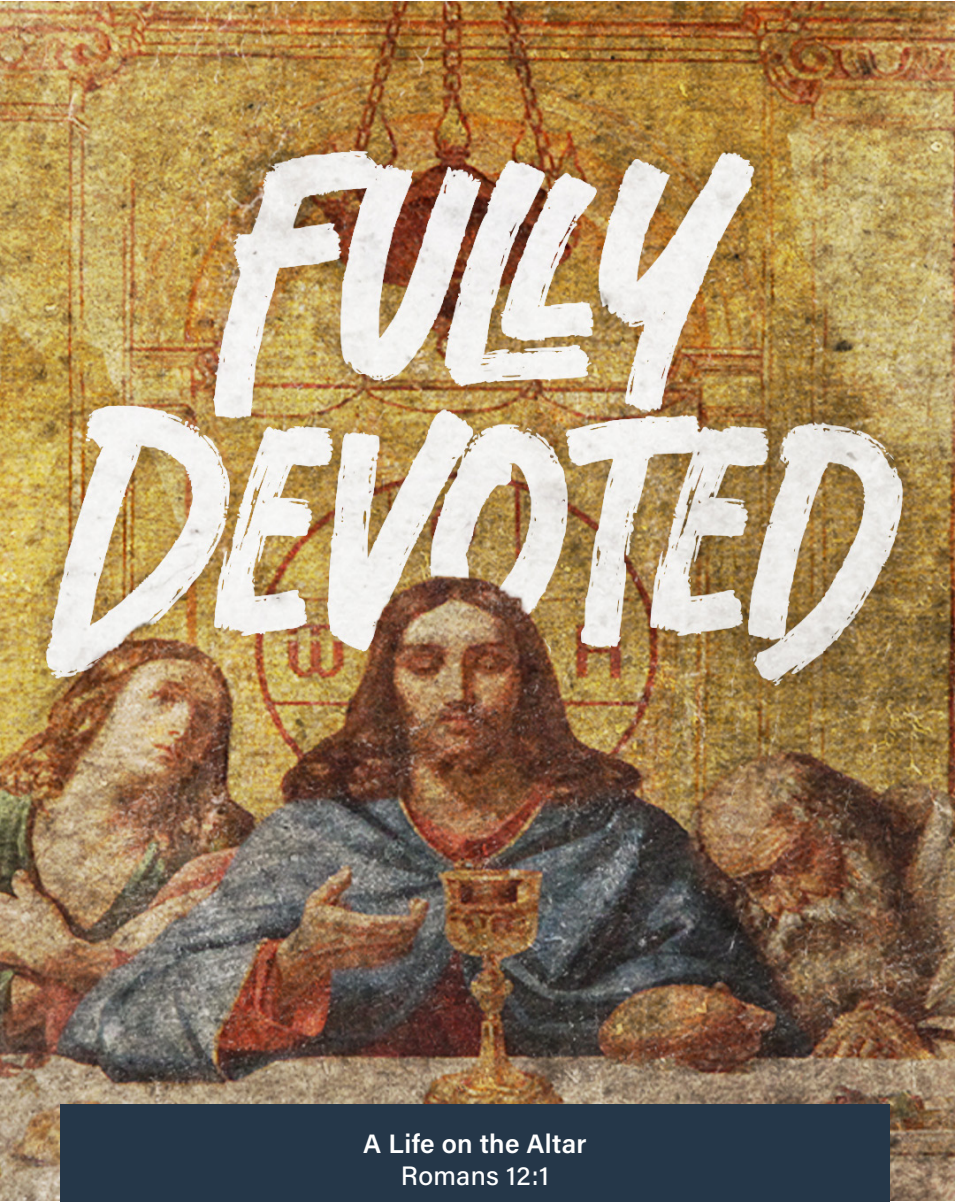
A Life on the Altar

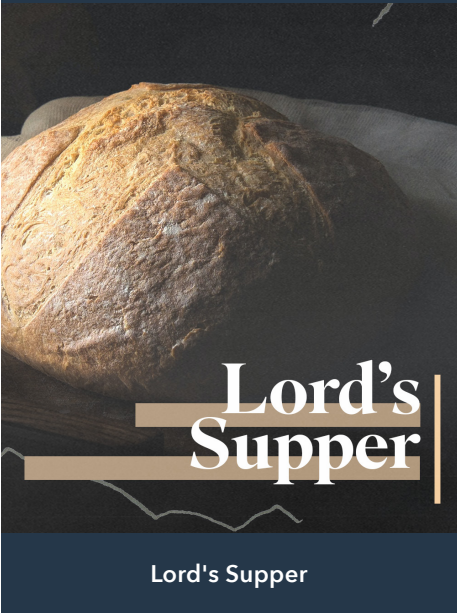
